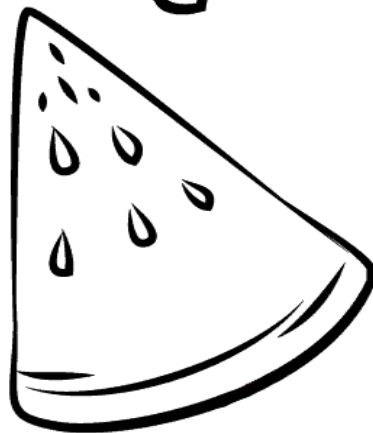
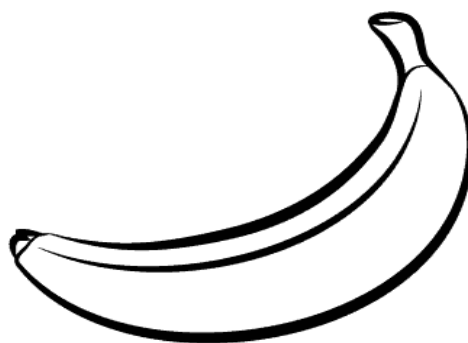
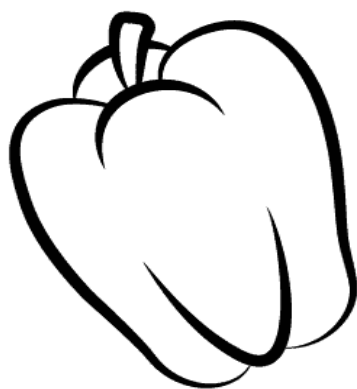
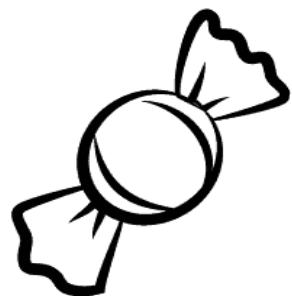
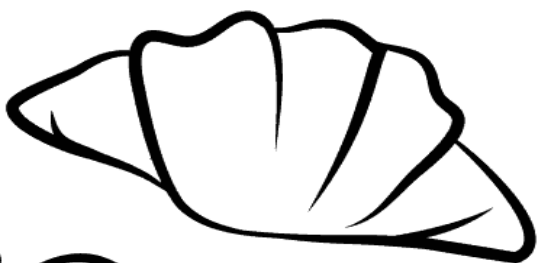
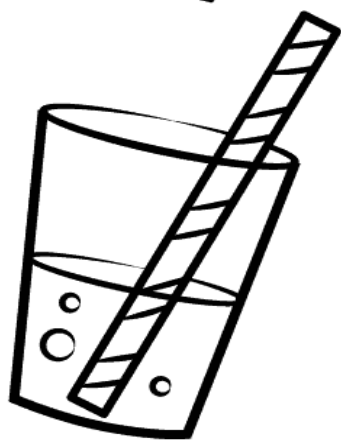
Fun Fact of the Month:
