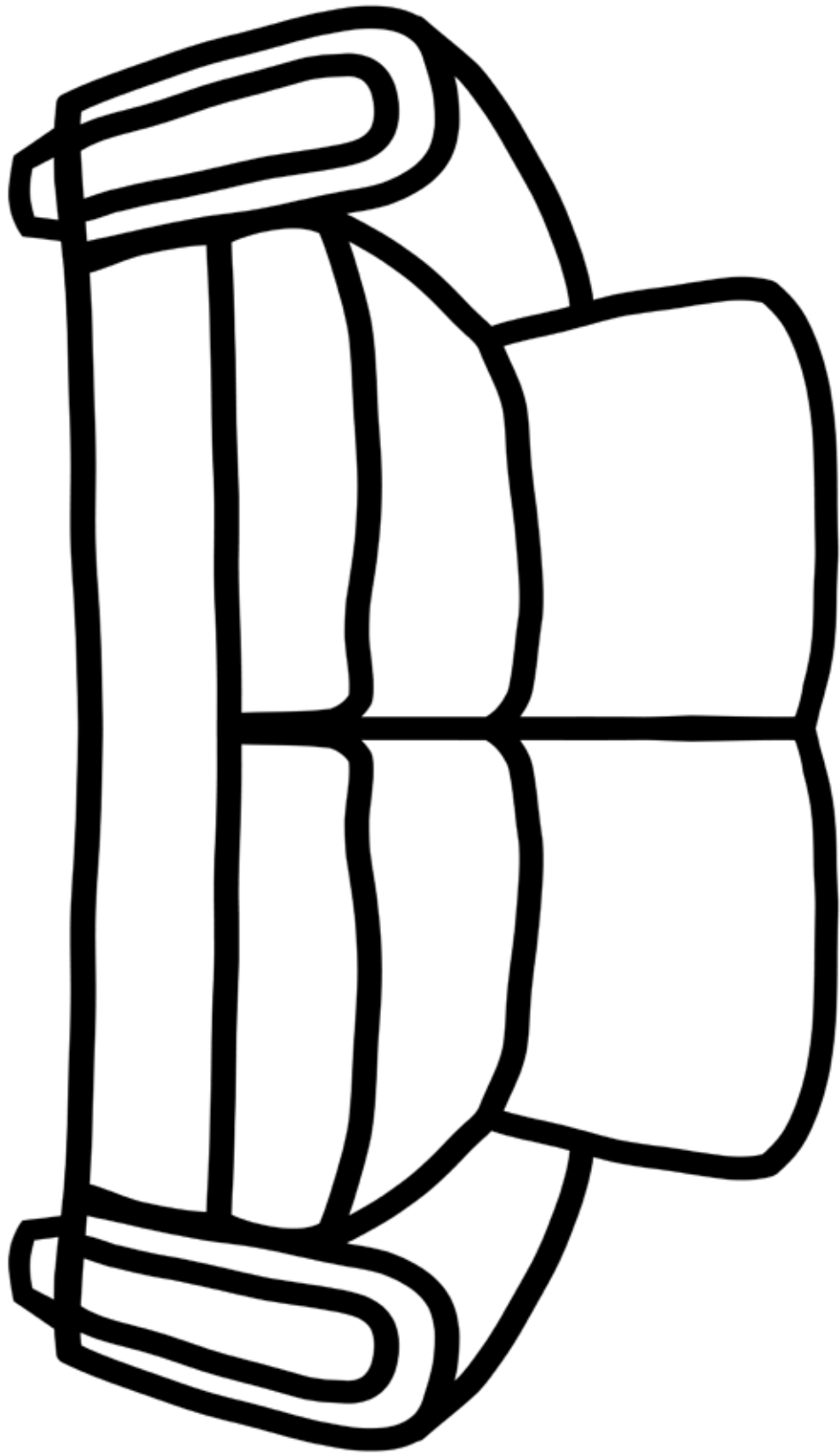
How Leap Day Balances Our Calendar:
