

Bunny Book Mark




Step 1:

Fold paper diagonally. Unfold.

Step 2:

Fold into a triangle (colored side on the outside). Grab hold of the top of the triangle (one sheet only) and fold it toward the bottom of the triangle.



Step 3:

Fold the left and right corner towards the bottom center of the triangle. Crease and unfold.

Step 4:

4. Again, grab the corner, this time folding it towards the top of the triangle. Crease well. Do the same with the other side.



Bunny Book Mark Cont.



Step 5:

Now tuck both tops inside the pocket.

Step 6:

Finish!

Now it's time to turn this DIY corner bookmark into a bunny corner bookmark.

Cut ears, teeth and snout and glue them on the corner bookmark. Also add two eye stickers (or just draw your own).

Notes:

I used doublesided tape since that's what I had around to test this. Seems to work just fine and my mother loves it and wants another one!
