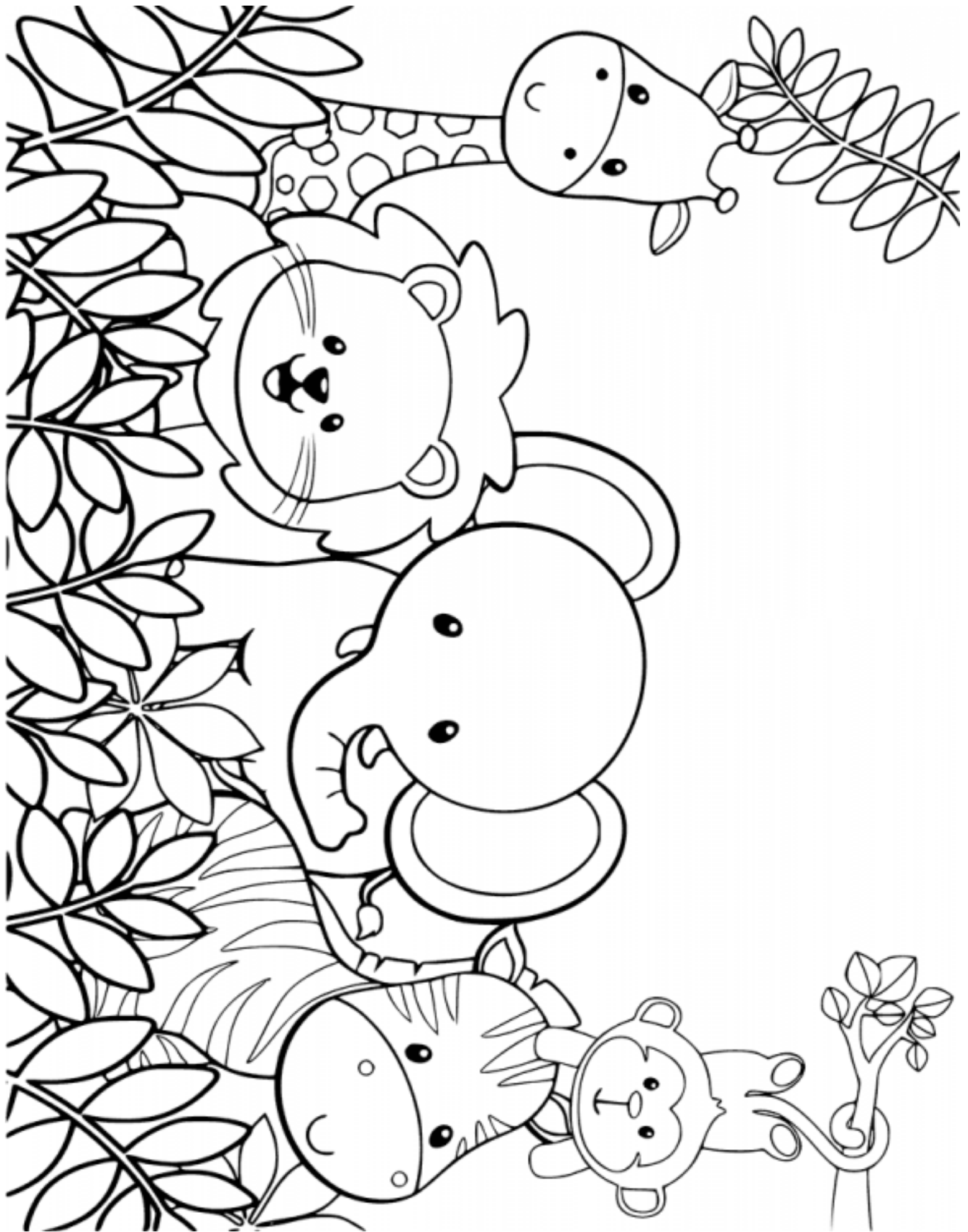
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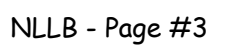
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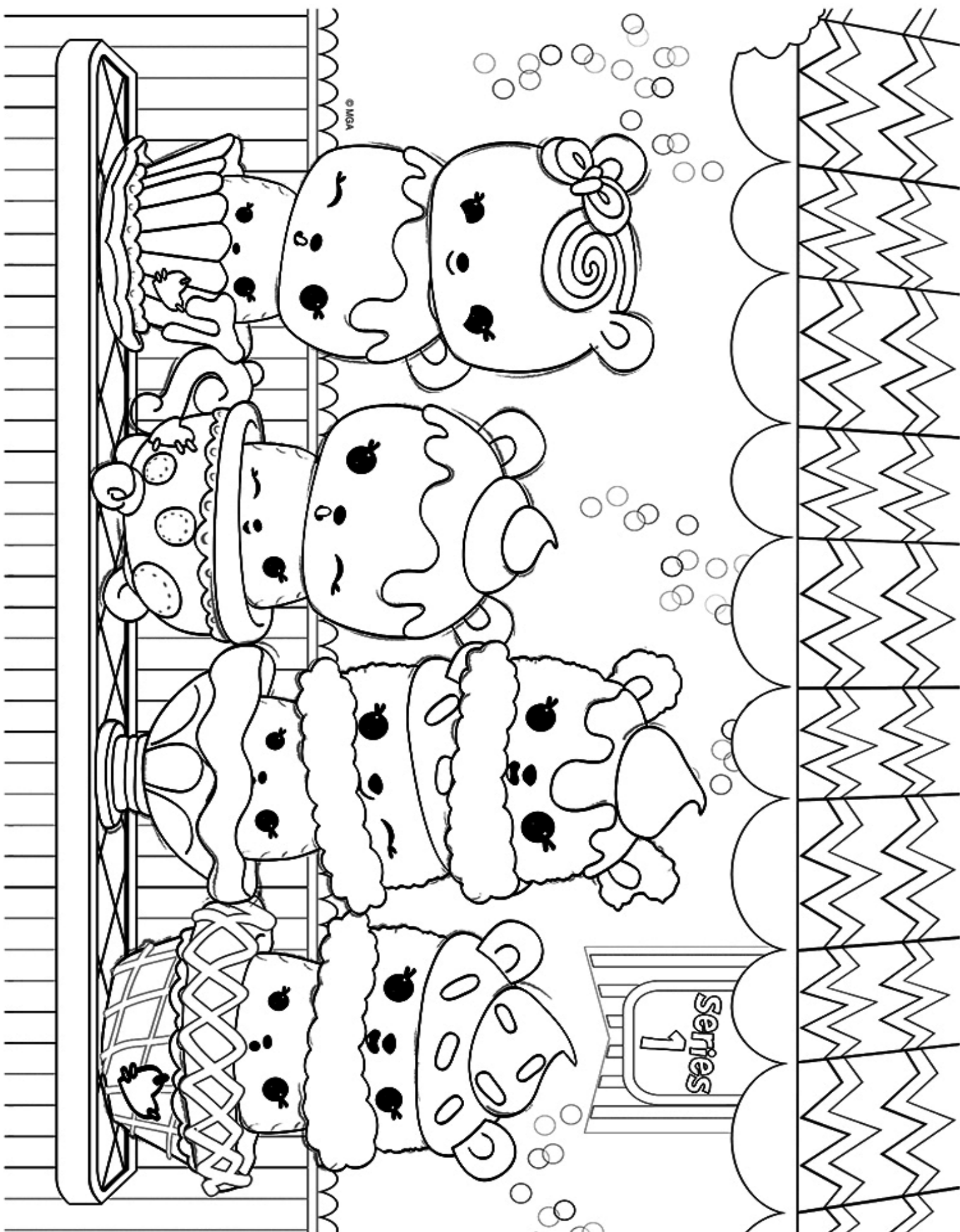
Helpful Notes:

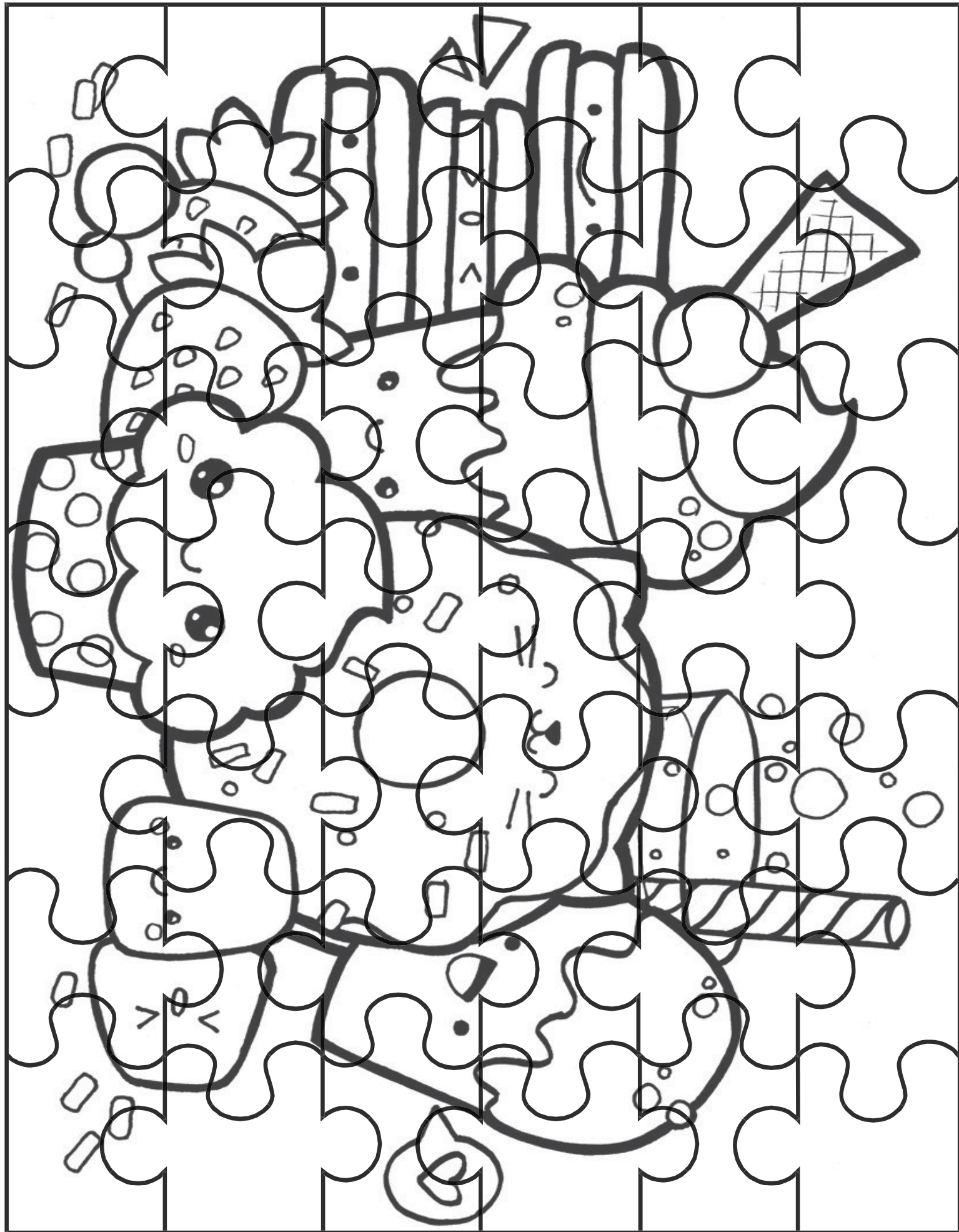




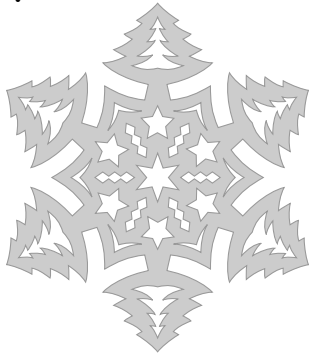




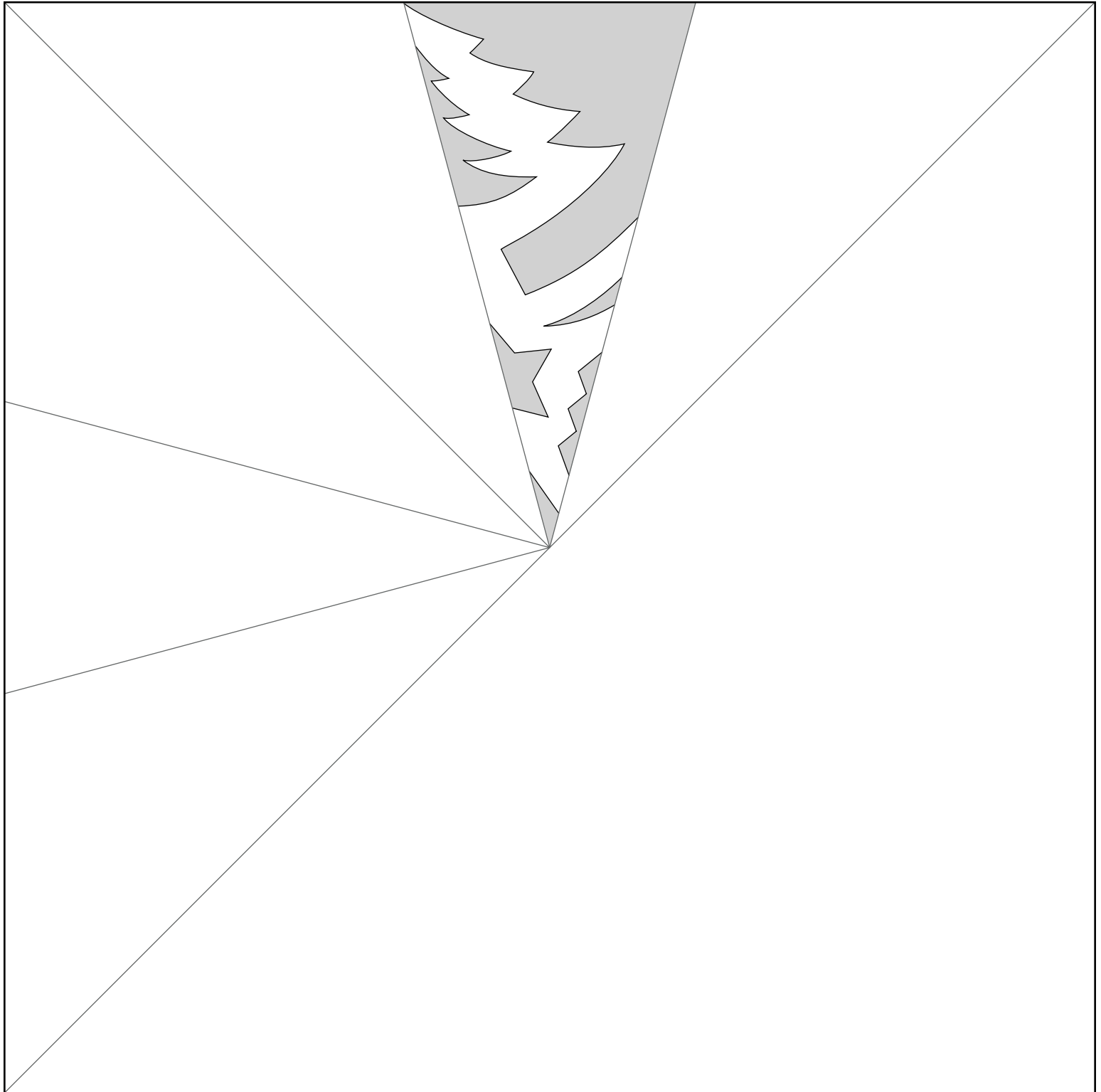




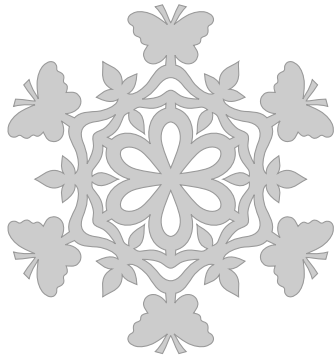
Paper Snowflake



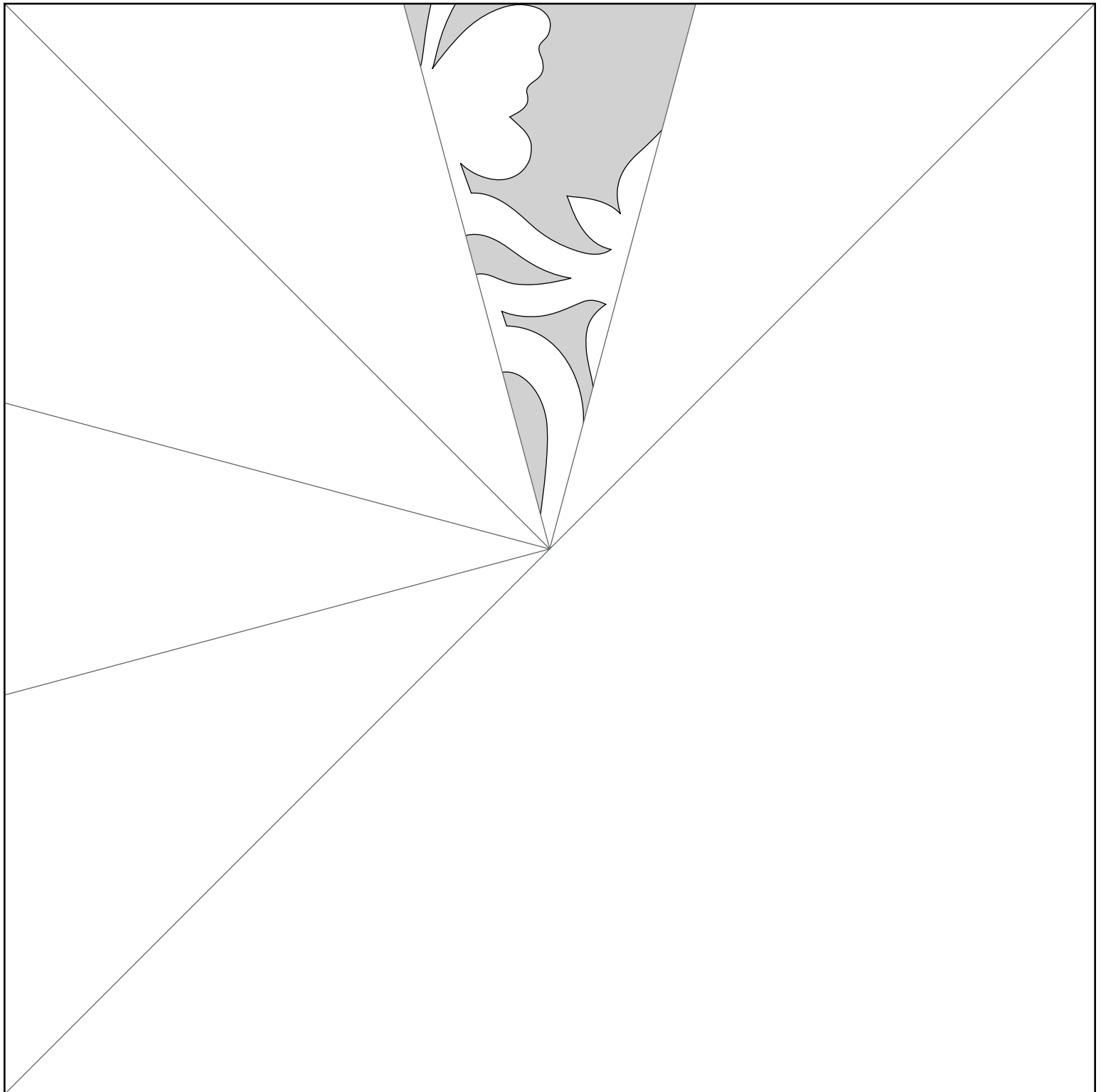
Cut out the square. Fold diagonally in half to come up with a triangle. Fold once more in half to get a smaller triangle. Fold the left section towards the back. Fold the right section towards the back as well. Cut away the gray area. Unfold the paper to reveal the snowflake.



Paper Snowflake



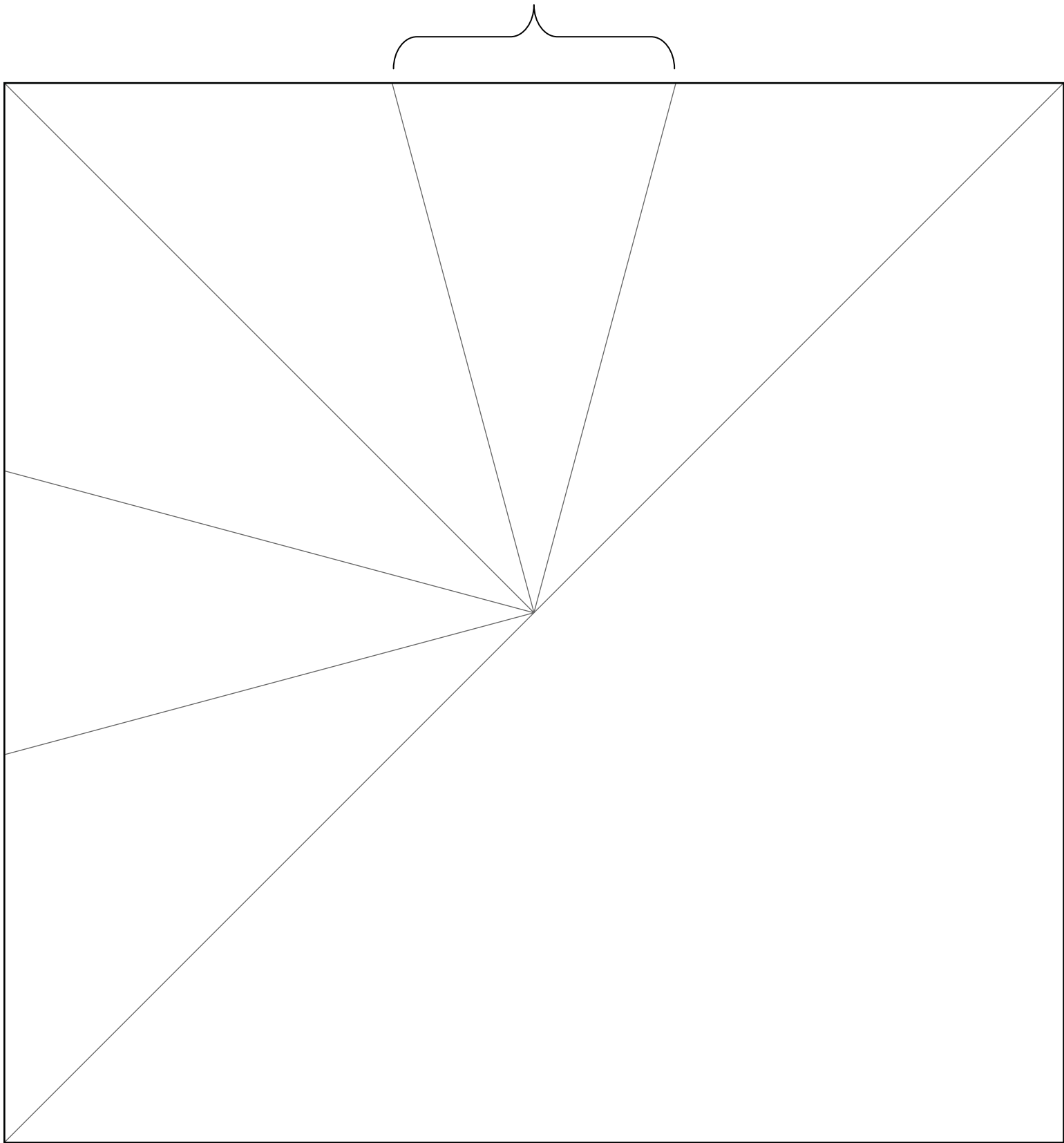
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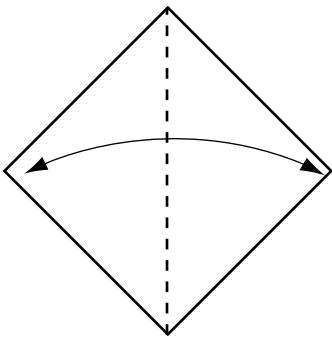


Paper Snowflake

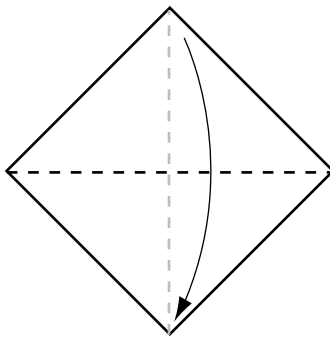

Draw your own snowflake design in this section

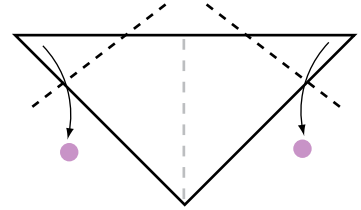




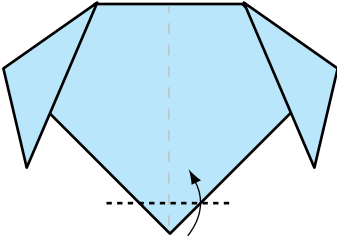
1. Start with your paper white side up. Fold in half then open.



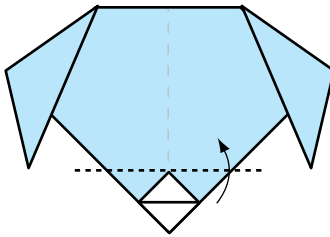
2. Fold the top corner down to the bottom corner.



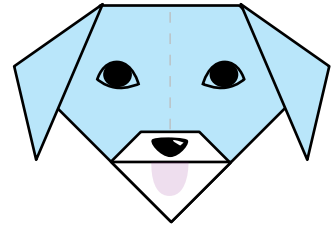
3. Fold the two top corners down to the points shown



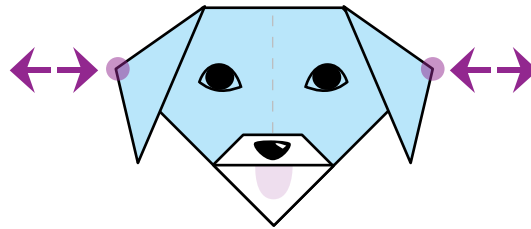
4. Fold the uppermost layer of the bottom corner up a little way



5. Fold this layer up again from the top of the triangle as shown



6. Add eyes and a nose to the dog's face. If you like you can even add a tongue!



To make your dog talk, hold the model by the ears and move back and forwards shown by the arrows.

No bake chocolate drop cookies

INGREDIENTS

- 3 Cups Quick Oats
- 5 Tbsp Unsweetened Cocoa Powder
- 1 Cup Shredded Coconut
- 2 1/4 Cups Granulated Sugar
- 1/2 Cup Milk
- 1/2 Cup Butter
- 2 tsp Vanilla Extract
- 1/2 Cup Chopped Nuts Optional

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Gather all your ingredients.
2. Combine Oats, Cocoa, and Shredded Coconut (and nuts if desired), in a bowl.
3. Add Sugar, Milk, Butter, and Vanilla to a sauce pan and heat till it just starts to boil while stirring. Pour over Oat mixture, mixing lightly to blend.
4. Drop about 3/4-1 inch "drops" onto wax paper or foil lined baking trays. Let stand until firm, approximately 10 mins, or place in the fridge for faster cooling.
